## ● ● ● INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH ● ● ● LANGUAGE TESTING SYSTEM ● ● ● (IELTS)

### **Description:**

The IELTS is the world's most popular English language proficiency test for higher education and global migration, with over 2 million tests taken in the last year.

Duration **2 3/4** hours

### **Scoring:**

The IELTS uses a 9-band scoring scale: A score from 1 to 9 is given for each part of the test – Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking. The average produces your overall band score. You can score whole (e.g., 5.0, 6.0, 7.0) or half (e.g., 5.5, 6.5, 7.5) bands in each part of the test.

## **TEST OF ENGLISH FOR INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATION (TOEIC)**

### **Description:**

The TOEIC assesses practical language skills used in daily life and in the workplace. Responses in English to real-world questions and scenarios in the spoken and written section are required. There is also a reading and listening section. The spoken and written sections can be taken as a separate test from the reading and listening sections.

Duration **2 1/2** hours

### **Scoring:**

The maximum score on TOEIC is 990 points. A reasonable score is above 700 points, a good score is anything above 800 points, and a great score is anything above 900 points.



● ● ● **TEST OF ENGLISH FOR  
FOREIGN LANGUAGE  
(TOEFL)**

**Description:**

The TOEFL is designed to measure the level of English proficiency of non-native English language speakers. It is accepted at many English-speaking academic and professional institutions.

Duration **between 2 1/2 and 3** hours

**Scoring:**

The maximum score on the TOEFL is 120. The test is broken into four parts, and the scores reflect that. Each of the four sections – reading, listening, speaking, and writing – is worth 30 points.
